

Law Enforcement Chain of Command

Police Chief

- Conduct day to day operations of the force
- Prescribe duties and assignments of personnel
- Investigate crime and apprehend offenders
- Administer and enforce disciplinary rules and regulations
- Report to appropriate authority

Appropriate Authority

- Issue rules and regulations for the operation and administration of police force
- Review reports from police chief
- Examine operations of police force and performance of individual police officers

Municipal Governing Body

- Investigate operation and administration of police force through NJSA
40:48-25

County Prosecutor

- Issue policies and procedures for the investigation of criminal offenses
- Direct the investigation of specific crimes
- Intervene in the operation of the police force when the delivery of police services and the enforcement of the law is wholly inadequate or compromised

Attorney General

- Exercise general supervision of law enforcement agencies
- Issue policies and procedures to ensure the uniform and efficient enforcement of the criminal law
- Inspect and review the operation of individual law enforcement agencies
